How do I create my mix? Here are some examples of a blended programme:

- Ensure your classroom delegates have reached a set level of understanding by getting them to complete a relevant e-learning module beforehand.
- Follow up face-to-face training by hosting an online discussion forum with delegates
- Ensure your new School Governors have viewed a relevant video or podcast before they attend a Governor meeting dealing with the same subject
- Ask all e-learners to complete a poll that you create, to stimulate discussion. Better still, do the poll before the course is taken, as well as after, and analyse how views have changed
